

Abortion Amendment Information Meeting: Proponents of abortions are collecting signatures for a ballot issued entitled "The Right to Reproductive Freedom and Safety with Protections for Health and Safety." They hope to get it on the November 2023 ballot. Should it pass, it will amend the Ohio Constitution and would provide for abortion on demand through all nine months of pregnancy, for any reason. The proposed Constitutional Amendment would remove safeguards that are currently in place to protect women and would remove parents from critical medical decisions that impact their children. We can't let this happen! We will be hosting representatives from the Greater Columbus Right to Life, the Diocese of Columbus' Office for Social Concerns, and the Catholic Medical Association on Wednesday, May 17 at 7:00 PM. I invite you to join with others to learn more about the proposed ballot initiative, what it would do, and what we can do to prevent this from becoming part of Ohio's Constitution. HELP PROTECT THE DIGNITY OF LIFE IN OHIO

Life in its earliest and most vulnerable stages is threatened by groups proposing an amendment to the Ohio Constitution for the November 2023 ballot to expand and enshrine abortion at the expense of protections for preborn children and women. The Catechism of the Catholic Church proclaims that "human life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception." The Church accompanies and supports women facing unexpected pregnancies and mothers through programs like Walking with Moms in Need and the services of Catholic Charities.



The bishops of Ohio strongly encourage Catholics statewide to unite in prayer and work to defeat this proposed amendment and its grave consequences for women and preborn children in Ohio. Starting this week, the following *Protect Them Both* materials about the proposed amendment are available in Ohio parishes:
