

"Battles of Bishop Rosecrans" Bishop Sylvester Rosecrans was named Bishop of Columbus in 1868 and died in 1878 after completing St. Joseph Cathedral. Some of the "battles" Bishop Rosecrans fought during his years as bishop will be discussed.
