






### **Peter's Pence Collection**

## **Defeat Ohio's Proposed Abortion Amendment**

The dignity of life in its earliest stages is threatened by a proposed Ohio Constitutional amendment to enshrine and expand abortion at the expense of protections for preborn children and women. #### **August Special Election**

A special election will take place in Ohio on August 8, 2023 to vote on Issue 1, which asks voters if Ohio should "Require that any proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Ohio receive the approval of at least 60 percent of eligible voters voting on the proposed amendment." As our bishops remind us, "In the Catholic Tradition, responsible citizenship is a virtue, and participation in political life is a moral obligation" Faithful Citizenship, No. 13. We urge you to register and vote in the upcoming election:

- July 10: Deadline to Register to Vote or Update Voter Information ·
- July 11 August 6: Absentee and Early In-Person Voting ·
- Tuesday August 8th: ELECTION DAY
