DEFEAT ABORTION IN OHIO



2023-2024 EASTERN CHRISTIAN FORMATION SCHOOL YEAR ECF 2023-24 Classes begin September 17th

After a successful academic year of 2022-23 our ECF program has significantly grown in numbers. Currently we have 4 groups: smallest children; 1 -3 Grade; 4-6 Grade; Middle School and High School.

Looking at the new year, we need more ECF teachers and assistants. See the description of the duties of an assistant and teacher below. Ideally, 2 parents per group with rotating schedule. In other words, with enough

parents volunteering, a parent would assist the group once a month. No skills required. ECF teachers, with more volunteers to teach, we intend to make the teaching more efficient. Possibility of rotation as well.

Assistant - preferably parents

- attends classes to help the teachers and the kids with activities, crafts, keep discipline, clean up afterwards.
- does not teach actually

ECF teacher

- safe environment program completed (online)
- enrolled in ECF teacher prep (at the Parish); we provide teaching material & method in advance
- 2 teachers per group
- 3 Sundays teaching, 1 off




PIROHI MAKING AND ROLL BAKING FOR 2023 COOKIE SALE





