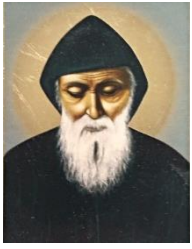
Stewardship Appeal 2023/24

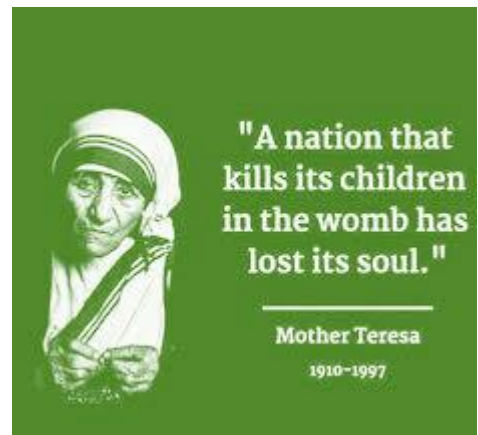
