CATHOLIC SCHOOL & EDCHOICE - Catholic schools are renowned for helping students grow in virtue and academic excellence...and are now more affordable for all families!

Ohio is blessed with 301 Catholic K-8 schools and 72 Catholic high schools across the state. Locally, we have <u>(make a reference to the elementary and high schools close to you)</u>. Now **ALL** Ohio students qualify for the EdChoice program. A family of four making \$140,400 per year or less is eligible for a full scholarship for each child in the amount of \$6,166 for K-8 and \$8,408 for grades 9-12. Families above that income level are eligible for scholarships awarded on a sliding scale based on income and household size, with no less than \$650 awarded per child.

Generous scholarships are also available for special needs students as well as students with Autism.

The best way to learn more is by contacting the Catholic K-8 or high school you are interested in your kid(s) attending. They will walk you through the entire process and help determine the scholarship amount per child for your family.
